











Did you know that, according to the KC, the perfect pug tail has 2 curls?


















Pugs have become a much loved family pet over the years and we've seen plenty cross our screens. Here are just a few familiar names:

Ever wondered where the name 'pug' comes from? Well, it means "a dwarf breed of dog resembling a bull-dog in miniature"





Pugs were considered prize possessions by Chinese emperors; some pugs were even given their own palaces, servants and guards!










